BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Initial plans for the 2007 summer school programs are well underway.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

- Elementary Summer School is a four-week intensive program in reading and math for students who have completed grades K-5 and are recommended for additional help to be successful at grade-level standards. Students will attend Cordova Lane Elementary School in Rancho Cordova and Oak Chan Elementary School in Folsom, June 11-July 6, from 8:45 a.m. to 12:25 p.m.
- English Language Accelerated Learning Camp for English Learners will focus on State English Language Development (ELD) standards, with emphasis on English vocabulary, grammar, reading comprehension, and fluency. This four-week program will be housed at Cordova Meadows Elementary School, June 11–July 6, from 8:45 a.m. to 12:25 p.m.
- Special Education extended year will be held at all three sites, and will be in session from 8:45 a.m. to 12:25 p.m. daily.
- A one-week GATE enrichment course will be offered at Navigator Elementary School, ~~June 11-July 6~~ June 11-15, from 8:30 a.m. to 11:50 a.m., for students who have just completed 3rd through 6th grades. Those students identified as gifted and high-achieving will be invited to attend the interdisciplinary, multi-age classes.

MIDDLE SCHOOL

- Middle school programs will be held on the Mills Middle School and Folsom High School campuses for grades 6-8, from June 12-July 7 (4 weeks), from 8:00 a.m. to 11:55 a.m.
- Middle school courses include grade-level remediation for language arts and mathematics only.
- Special Education classes will be offered at both schools.
- ELD classes will be offered at Mills Middle only.

HIGH SCHOOL

- High school programs will be held at both Cordova and Folsom High Schools for grades 9-12, from June 12–July 21 (6 weeks), from 8:00 a.m.–12:45 p.m. Students may take one or two classes, earning 5 credits per class.
- All core academic English, math, science, and social studies classes are offered as remedial courses for those students who have previously failed or want to improve a grade in that course.
- Enrichment classes are limited to driver education, family life, 10th-12th grade physical education, US history, and government/economics.
- Special Education classes will be offered at both Cordova and Folsom High Schools.
- CAHSEE tutorial classes will be offered in language arts and math at both schools.
- ESL classes will be offered at Cordova High School.

Mather Youth Academy, grades 7-12

- MYA will conduct an extended year program, June 12–July 7 (4 weeks), from 8:00 a.m.–2:30 p.m. Courses are remedial in nature.
- CAHSEE tutorial classes will be offered for high school students.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Summer School will be funded through hourly programs revenue, Community Day School, Title 1, and Economic Impact Aid (EIA)
