- Would be more comfortable with the course if the list of units of instruction were exclusive.

- Corrections:
  - In the Detailed Units of Instruction, Part I, Issue 7 – the word “safe” should be “sale.”
  - Under Part I, Issue 9 “Should stem cell research be permitted?” We just passed a bond in California to support it.
- How this course is taught is the important part, not the subject itself.
- Adults can’t even discuss these topics civilly, how can kids?
- Teachers, like other human beings, have strong feelings about these issues. How do you keep those feelings out of the classroom?
- This would be a great college course.

Ms. Stanley

- Can not support the motion.
- Suggested amendments to the motion:
  - Set this up as a one semester, one class, one teacher pilot at Cordova High School.
  - Require parental approval for students to take the course.
  - Monitor and review at the end of the semester.
  - Survey students to ensure that they were able to present their views without feeling influenced by the teacher.

### **DISCUSSION/ACTION**

**0607-258 – Adopt 2007-2008 Proposed Budget and Revise 2006-2007 Budget**

Superintendent Godwin introduced Deputy Superintendent/CFO Debbie Bettencourt.

Ms. Bettencourt recognized Rhonda Crawford and Annette Heldman for their many hours of work on this budget. In a PowerPoint presentation, she reviewed the document, revenues, and expenditures.

- This year is an unremarkable year for us. We do have a COLA, slight enrollment growth for the District, and no one-time dollars because the state economy is slowing down.
- The pure definition of deficit spending is comparing current year revenue to current year expenses. We are deficit spending \$2.1 million dollars; however, we do have carryover revenues.
- Taking the 2007-2008 budget and doing a multi-year projection, we make the following assumptions for the next two years, 2008-2009 and 2009-2010: a 1% enrollment growth, that we will have a state-funded COLA, that 75% of that COLA will be negotiated to the employee groups, that health and welfare will increase 5%, and that no other increase will be given to other expenses. Maybe hopeful, but that’s what we assume to see where we will be. If nothing changed

in those assumptions, in 2008-2009, would have a \$5.8 million shortfall, and in 2009-2010, an \$11.4 million shortfall.

- To avoid deficits in those two years, we have some options. Options could include increasing ADA by increasing student days in their seats, adding new students through District programs such as our foreign language magnet program, and a housing market rebound, coupled with some decreases in expenditures such as staffing, electricity, supplies and materials, programs and services, contributions to deferred maintenance, and contributions to our retiree fund. The last two options have some implications because we would just be deferring maintenance and deferring liability for retirees.
- Our plan is to work with employee organizations for review and understanding of the budget, because we will need to negotiate in 2008-2009. With that committee, there will be emphasis in the fall to bring back to the Board recommendations January, February, and no later than March for how we're going to resolve this issue for 2008-2009.

Mr. Short

- Excellent job, but is concerned about deficit spending. How much of the percentage of the shortfall is part of the renegotiated amounts to the employee organizations?

Ms. Bettencourt

- All of it is, or none of it is. You could say it's all related to the opening of Vista del Lago and Russell Ranch. You could say it's related to special education. It's really a combination of all of those things.

Mr. Godwin

- Perhaps the answer to Mr. Short's question could be explaining what a 1% salary increase to all of our employees costs.

Ms. Bettencourt

- When we receive a 1% increase from the state, it's about \$900,000. When we give a 1% salary increase, it's about \$960,000.

Mr. Benton

- At the end of the day, are we okay?

Ms. Bettencourt

- Answered that we will be.

Mr. Godwin

- Unfortunately, in the state of California, districts are perpetually required to find a way to kick this financial can further down the road, and the concern is always that one of these days that can will become a 50-gallon drum, and we won't be able to kick it. The job we have this year is to take a look at how we can make sure we don't get trapped in that kind of situation. We will be looking at revenue enhancements and also ways for us to control our costs. A lot of that will involve a greater understanding from our employee associations. Is disappointed that they are not in attendance tonight.

McCORMICK/BENTON MOVED TO ADOPT the revised budget for 2006-2007 and other revisions required to complete year-end closing, and ADOPT the 2007-2008 proposed budget.  
MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

**0607-259 – Approve 2007-08 Salary Increase and Benefits for Certificated Administrators, Classified Management, and Confidential Employees**

Superintendent Godwin explained that earlier this year, the Board approved classified and certificated salary and benefit increases for 2007-2008. This was not done for certificated administrators, classified management, or confidential employees. The Board is being asked to approve the same package that was negotiated for the other employee groups.

BENTON/SHORT MOVED TO APPROVE the 2007-2008 salary increase and benefits for certificated administrators, classified management, and confidential employees.
