## **Instruction**

### **SUMMER SCHOOL**

**BP 6177**

The Governing Board recognizes that summer school provides valuable opportunities for students to improve their skills and make academic progress. When the need is demonstrated and funds are available, the Superintendent or designee, with Board approval, shall establish summer school day and/or evening classes for purposes of remediation, enrichment or acceleration.

#### **Admission**

First priority to enroll in summer high school classes shall be given to District students who need course credits in order to graduate by September or who were assessed as not meeting the District's adopted standards of proficiency in basic skills.

To the extent that space is available after District students have enrolled, remaining openings in summer high school classes for core academic subjects may be open to private school students with Superintendent or designee approval. Summer school classes will conform to the remediation requirements of the Promotion/Retention state standards.

#### **Attendance**

Because summer courses cover extensive instructional content in a relatively short time period, consistent class attendance is crucial.

Students who have more than three absences may not receive credit for their summer session class(es).
