Carl H. Sundahl Elementary School Traffic Safety Alert-Revised

In the interest of safety for all of our students while they are at Sundahl Elementary School, the staff and members of the Safety Committee, made up of staff and parents, would again like to ask for your continued cooperation and adherence to the following procedures:

Drop Off Procedures:

Please drop your students off in the parking lot **at the crosswalk area** (yellow area in parking lot). It is very dangerous for children to be crossing at other locations. Please consider parking your car on the street and walking your child to the front of the school – easy exercise for both of you!

Pick Up Procedures:

Always drive slowly through the parking lot and please be patient. **Once the buses leave**, you may pull up along the curb. Please respect the crosswalk area and be very careful when pulling out and around the waiting cars, as children do not always look as carefully as they should. Again, please consider parking your car on the street and walking over to meet your student(s).

Additional Reminders:

- ◆ Bus Loading Zone & Fire Lane
 - Keep clear for bus entrance, loading and unloading
 - Use extra caution using lane when buses are parked
 - If using for drop off or pickup, remain in the car, do not park
- ◆ Student Care/Kindergarten Lot
 - Short term parking only, NO drop off or pickup
- ◆ Do not block Inwood Road at entrance to student drop off
- ◆ Students should wait for pickup at flagpole or in front of office
