Message From your School Nurse

September 12, 2007

Welcome back. I hope that all of your children are again settling into their school routine, although a bit earlier than previous years.

My name is Denise Ryhal and I am your school nurse at Carl Sundahl Elementary. This is my 10th year at Sundahl! A little background on me: I've earned a B.S. in Nursing and obtained my School Nurse Credential in 1986. I cover 2 elementary schools in Folsom. If I have not already met you, please stop by and introduce yourself, especially if your child has any health or medical conditions.

If case your child needs to have a **medication** available for him/her at school, let me quickly highlight the district's policy on medications on campus. Prescription medications need to be in their original container with the Rx label attached, along with a signed authorization by both parent and physician. Over-the-counter meds need only a parent authorization and meds in their original container. Please write your child's name on the container, but not covering the dosage directions. If your physician has directed you to give your child an OTC medication at a higher dosage than the usual dosing shown on the container, we would also need both a parent and physician signed authorization.

It is the time of year when all new Kindergarten students must be current on their **immunizations** in order to enter school. During the first weeks of school, we will be checking all records for current immunizations. If you have not yet done so, please provide your child's most current records to the Health Office. We will be following up with reminders to those who are not current. Please understand if immunizations are not current, by law we are required to exclude that child from attending school until immunizations are current. Many thanks to parents who have obtained the necessary immunizations for your child!
