FULL TEXT BALLOT PROPOSITION SCHOOL FACILITIES IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 OF THE FOLSOM CORDOVA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT BOND MEASURE ELECTION MARCH 5, 2001

The following is the full proposition presented to the voters by the School Facilities Improvement District No. 1 of The Folsom Cordova Unified School District.

“For Rancho Cordova only, to renovate classrooms and school buildings, acquire land, construct new school facilities, install technology improvements, and qualify for available state matching funds, shall School Facilities Improvement District No. 1 of the Folsom Cordova Unified School District issue \$49 million of bonds at legal interest rates, appoint a Citizens Oversight Committee, and perform annual financial and performance audits, with no proceeds used for administrator or teacher salaries or other school operating expenses?”

The Folsom Cordova Unified School District Board of Education has evaluated safety, class size reduction, and information technology needs in developing the list of school facilities projects to be funded, as outlined in the District’s Facilities Master Plan. The Facilities Master Plan approved by the Board on January 18, 2001 shall be amended from time to time.

Projects include but are not limited to:

Renovate

- ❖ Reymouth Center
- ❖ Riverview Elementary School
- ❖ Community Education Center
- ❖ Kitty Hawk Elementary School
- ❖ Cordova High School
- ❖ Mitchell Middle School
- ❖ Mills Middle School
- ❖ Williamson Elementary School
- ❖ White Rock Elementary School
- ❖ Rancho Cordova Elementary School
- ❖ Peter J. Shields Elementary School
- ❖ Mather Heights Elementary School
- ❖ Kinney High School
- ❖ Cordova Meadows Elementary School
- ❖ Cordova Lane Elementary School
- ❖ Cordova Gardens Elementary School

Improvements generally include the following items depending on the specific school needs. Please see the District’s January 18, 2001 Facilities Master Plan and subsequent revisions for more information on each school.

- ❖ Replace heating, ventilating, and air-conditioning (HVAC) units as needed
- ❖ Replace interior finishes including floors, wall surfaces, and ceilings
- ❖ Install new fixtures including white boards, casework, and cabinets
- ❖ Upgrade toilet rooms including accessibility, toilets, sinks, and partitions
- ❖ Install Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessibility upgrades throughout campus
- ❖ Replace exterior doors and lock hardware
- ❖ Repair or replace roofs as needed
- ❖ Upgrade electrical system and increase power capacity in classrooms for technology
- ❖ Install new and current technology including computers, communications equipment, improved local and wide area network access, high-speed internet access, and infrastructure cabling as needed on each Rancho Cordova Campus
- ❖ Furnish new signal systems, including telephone, intercom, clocks, bells, fire alarm, and intrusion alarm for safety
- ❖ Install new energy efficient lighting fixtures and controls
- ❖ Make dry rot and termite damage repairs and abate asbestos materials
- ❖ Replace old furniture

Additional projects may include:

- ❖ Acquire land and construct an elementary school for the students from Villages of Zinfandel subdivision
- ❖ Replace 20-year old portable classrooms at various schools, construct lab classrooms, and multipurpose rooms
- ❖ For high school students, replace old portables at Cordova High School, acquire land, design and begin construction of a second high school for the Rancho Cordova area
- ❖ Construct site improvements, additional classrooms, and facilities for Rancho Cordova students
