

# FOLSOM SCHOOL BOND

## Fast Facts

- Folsom will need classrooms for 3,100 *new* elementary students and 1,500 *additional* high school students at build-out of the existing City boundaries.
- Passage of this bond will provide for both renovations and new construction projects in Folsom.
- Projects will be completed at every school in Folsom. Some of the major projects will be to:
  - ✓ Renovate Theodore Judah, Blanche Sprentz, and Folsom Middle schools
  - ✓ Install technology improvements at existing schools
  - ✓ Construct Prairie Oaks Elementary School
  - ✓ Construct a second high school
  - ✓ Construct a gym and locker rooms at Folsom Middle School
  - ✓ Construct a drama classroom and fine arts theater at Folsom High School
  - ✓ Construct athletic facilities, including fields, track, and seating at Folsom High School

- All funds from this Folsom school bond can be spent **ONLY** on facilities and **ONLY** in Folsom. Only Folsom voters will be voting on this \$53 million bond.
- All expenditures will be reviewed by a Citizens Oversight Committee consisting of one member active in each of the following groups/organizations: business, seniors, taxpayers, building industry, as well as a parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the district, and two parents or guardians that are active in parent-teacher organizations.
- Passage of this bond will allow the school district to collect State-matching funds.
- This school bond will cost the average homeowner in Folsom \$7.25/month.
