Notice of Intent to Adopt a Negative Declaration

The Folsom Cordova Unified School District is the Lead Agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for the proposed project identified below. This notice is to advise that a Negative Declaration and Initial Study has been prepared for the Cordova High School Measure N Modernization Project. This public Notice of Availability and Intent to Adopt a Negative Declaration is being provided in compliance with Title 14, Chapter 3, Sections 15072 and 15073 of the California Code of Regulations, as amended.

PROJECT TITLE: Cordova High School Measure N Modernization and New Construction

PROJECT LOCATION: The proposed project site is at the Cordova High School campus located at 2239 Chase Drive in Rancho Cordova, Sacramento County, California.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The project consists of a multi-year improvement plan of seven phases projected through the year 2014 and beyond depending on funding. The major components include remodeling of existing buildings, relocation of and removal of portables once new classrooms are constructed, a new performing arts building, cafeteria remodel, construction of a new auxiliary gym, site work, stadium improvements, on site circulation routes and parking lot improvements, and utility extensions.

BOARD HEARING: The Governing Board of Education of the Folsom Cordova Unified School District will consider this item at a meeting tentatively planned for **September 16, 2010, at 6:00 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as possible. The Board meeting will be held at Mills Middle School, 10439 Coloma Road, Rancho Cordova, 95670. Agencies, organizations, and interested parties are welcome to attend and comment on the Negative Declaration.
