

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION

NOTICE is hereby given that the Folsom Cordova Unified School District, State of California intends to adopt a Negative Declaration for the project described below.

TITLE: FOLSOM CORDOVA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT EDUCATION SERVICES CENTER

LOCATION: The project site is located on Alabama Avenue, approximately 500 feet south of Folsom Boulevard

GENERAL DESCRIPTION: The project consists of five distinct activities: the construction of an office building and appurtenant facilities (parking, access, etc) on a 5.3-acre property, the construction of a drainage swale leading to a detention basin on a 5.3-acre area, the installation of sewer improvements to provide sewer service to the office building site, the installation of water improvements to provide water service to the office building site, and the stockpiling of soil removed for the basin, swale, sewer improvements, water improvements and office building on a 5.5-acre area. For purposes of the grading permits, the **Sacramento County Control Number is 2009-70047.**
