WHAT IS SAWWA?

The Sacramento Area Water Works Association is a non-profit organization comprised of water purveyors, engineers, and local vendors with the following main objectives:

- To advance and implement improvements in knowledge, design, construction, operation, and management of water utilities;
- To consider and solve problems in the production and distribution of safe, adequate water supplies;
- To promote the dissemination of water utility information to improve the understanding of the complexities of the industry; and
- To offer to members of the Association, their organizations, and to other appropriate persons or organizations the individual or collective water utility expertise that is available from members of the Association.

WHO CAN APPLY FOR THE 12th ANNUAL SAWWA SCHOLARSHIP?

To apply for this scholarship, you must meet the following conditions:

• Currently enrolled or intention to enroll in post high school education by attending an accredited 4 year college, a community college, or trade school in the 2024-2025 school year.

WATER RESOURCES FOCUS

• Students enrolled in a program with a focus on water resources are encouraged to apply but is not a requirement.

WHEN IS THE LAST DAY TO APPLY?

Applications must be received no later than **Friday**, MAY **17**, **2024**, **at 5PM**.

WHAT IS THE VALUE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP?

SAWWA will select up to THREE (3) winners from the applications received and each winner will receive a scholarship for \$1,000. The winners will be notified via email and telephone by June 14, 2024, and recognized at the SAWWA July 18, 2024, General Meeting.

Each \$1,000 Scholarship will be paid directly to the winner. If the winner is a minor, the Scholarship check will be presented to the winner's parent or guardian. No substitution or transfer of prizes is permitted. Any taxes due on the Scholarship prize or any other prizes awarded are the sole responsibility of the winner and/or his or her parent or guardian.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

All scholarship applicants must include the following documents with this application:

- 1. Application form (this page) completely filled out.
- 2. An **official School Transcript** with the most recent grades.
- 3. <u>Proof of acceptance</u> to a 4 year college, community college or trade school in the upcoming school year.
- 4. A <u>Personal Statement/Essay one page maximum</u> in length typed single spaced with 1-inch margins. Include information about yourself, your financial need, your aspirations/goals, community involvement, awards, work history, and your interests.
- 5. <u>Two letters of recommendation</u> from non-family members. Include contact information in case we need to contact the reference.

Selection Criteria

Primary Criteria: Financial need, academic achievement (including grades, rank in class, standardized test

scores and achievement test scores)

Secondary Criteria: Community involvement, leadership traits, awards and recognition, work history,

personal or family attributes

Bonus Points: Applicants demonstrating further education focus in water engineering studies will receive

bonus points (see rating below).
