Purpose:

Mission:

Our mission is to increase access and opportunity for African American students in the Greater Sacramento Area to quality institutions of higher education. By alleviating the financial burden of college and providing mentorship, our goal is to ensure that scholarship recipients emerge as thriving students and future leaders committed to serving the Sacramento community.

Target population:

African American students from the Greater Sacramento Area, who are admitted freshmen, continuing undergraduates, or community college students.

Scholarship Eligibility Criteria:

- Minimum grade point average/HS Grads 3.00; Continuing undergrads 2.5.
- Minumum grade point average for graduate or professional school students 3.0.
- Admitted/enrolled in an accredited college or university.
- Priority given to STEM Pathway. However, all academic fields of study are welcome.
- Demonstrated commitment to and evidence of community service.

Application Review and Selection Process:

The Gamma Epsilon Foundation Scholarship Committee will post the application on its website, and send announcements out to the various educational institutions in the Greater Sacramento Area. Applications will be reviewed by the committee and select those students who best match the established scholarship criteria.

Scholarships will be awared on July 22, of 2024, at a scholarship recognition dinner held at the Catta Verdera Country Club, 1111 Catta Verdera Lincoln, California 95648.
