



# Empire Oaks Elementary 2020-21 COVID-19 Family Agreement



All of us at Empire Oaks Elementary are VERY excited to welcome our students and families back on campus! We also want you to know that Empire Oaks takes the health and well-being of our students, teachers, and staff very seriously. We commit to partnering with you to do all we can to ensure a safe and productive year for our students. Please read the commitments below and return the signature page to your homeroom teacher as a symbol of your agreement to partner with Empire Oaks during this unprecedented time. If we ALL work together and adhere to this agreement, then we as a school community are doing everything possible to keep our classrooms open for in-person instruction. We appreciate our families and believe that WE CAN DO THIS! The District response plan and procedures are not exhaustive and will be adjusted as guidelines change with the evolving situation. We will continue to be in close contact with Sacramento County Public Health.

\_\_\_I commit to screen my child for symptoms consistent with COVID-19 every morning or afternoon before bringing him/her to school. FCUSD will communicate and offer training for the symptom screening app when available.

\_\_\_I commit to following the [SCPH Response Scenarios](#) and get tested if I, or my children, demonstrate symptoms of COVID or have known exposure.

\_\_\_I commit to communicate with the school of any [symptoms](#) or positive results/positive known exposure so that proper quarantine can be implemented to those affected. Please refer to this [Decision Tree](#).

\_\_\_I commit to being available to come pick up my child within 30 minutes if they are ill.

\_\_\_I commit to wearing a face covering and will maintain physical distance if I *need* to go to the office. Please utilize email and phone calls whenever possible.

\_\_\_I commit to have my child wear a face covering. Wear masks with two or more layers over the nose and mouth and secure it under the chin. Do NOT wear masks intended for healthcare workers, for example, N95 respirators.

CDC does not recommend the use of gaiters or face shields. Evaluation of these face covers is on-going but effectiveness is unknown at this time. Follow guidelines about materials and quality of face coverings.

\_\_\_I commit to encouraging my child to practice physical distancing while at school.

\_\_\_I commit to encouraging my child to practice healthy hygiene habits including hand washing and hand sanitizing.

\_\_\_I commit to ensuring my child leaves personal toys, balls, and such at home.



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\_\_\_ I commit to reminding my child that playgrounds are closed during school hours until further notice.

\_\_\_ I commit to send my child with a water bottle each day. If you do not have one, contact the office.

\_\_\_ I commit to reminding my child to refrain from sharing materials/supplies.

\_\_\_ I commit to following FCUSD safety procedures and protocols. The procedures are not exhaustive and will be adjusted as guidelines change with the situation.

\_\_\_ I commit to encourage/help my child log in to complete the independent learning each day.

\_\_\_ I commit to picking up my child on time when their school day is over.

\_\_\_ I commit to making sure my child takes care of their Chromebook and keeps it charged.

\_\_\_ If my child rides the bus, I commit to promote physical distancing at the bus stop.

\_\_\_ If my child walks to and from school, I commit to encouraging my child to practice physical distancing.

\_\_\_ I commit to following drop-off and pick-up procedures and that those procedures may change to accommodate the situation. I commit to wearing a face covering and will practice physical distancing.

*\*Parents are not permitted on campus during school hours and therefore your student cannot be met at their classroom.*

\_\_\_ I commit to standard Immunization regulations required for school entry.

California school immunization law requires students to receive immunizations before entry to pre-kindergarten (child care or preschool) and school. Please ensure that your child is up to date with their required immunizations. Elementary school students should receive their immunizations by November 9th and middle school students should receive their immunizations by November 30th. If they do not receive their immunizations, they will need to enroll in the Virtual Academy.
