Oak Chan Families,

We've missed seeing our Oak Chan students 'in-person' and we're excited to welcome them safely back to school. As we prepare for their return, we're reaching out to share campus-wide expectations for in-person instruction. Please be mindful of these details as you establish new routines at home with your student.

Symptom Check

It's important that you include a symptom check of your child as part of your morning routine. If your child is displaying any symptoms such as fever, cough, difficulty breathing, loss of taste or smell, headache, sore throat, congestion, nausea, or fatigue, then please keep your child home and notify our office at 916-294-9155. A FCUSD Symptom Screening Checklist for parents will be sent home next Friday.

Schedules

There are two sessions for in-person instruction. Our AM session is 8:25-11:00am and our PM session is 12:00-2:37pm Tuesday through Friday. Monday will continue to be a distance learning day for all students. Those continuing in a Distance Learning format (Virtual Academy), will receive a detailed schedule from the DL teacher. Also, for our DL learners, Fridays will remain our materials pick-up and student work drop-off days.

Pick Up/Drop Off

We have designated four locations (Gate's 1, 2, 3, and 4) around campus for pick-up and drop-off of students. Siblings can go together through one gate. In an effort to prevent gatherings, students may not enter campus until right before their session begins; 8:15am or 11:50am. Students also must go directly to their designated line-up area in front of their teacher's classroom at arrival and leave campus immediately upon dismissal. We also ask that adults wear masks and practice social distancing. Only students and OC staff members may cross the RED SKORR line and walk past the main gates.

*During the first couple of days, staff members will assist in directing students to their line-up areas.

Instruction

Our teachers will be emphasizing reading and math during in-person instruction. Activities in other subject areas will be provided by your child's teacher for use during asynchronous instruction at home. Chromebooks are to be left at home; teachers will designate specific days to bring to school for assessment or special assignments.

Masks and Social Distancing

Students and staff are expected to wear masks at all times. Mask medical exemptions are handled on a case by-case basis through our school nurse and require a verified doctor's note. If this is the case, for the well-being of others, we suggest that a child wear a shield with a drape. Everyone is expected to practice social distancing whenever possible. Close encounters between students and their teacher will be brief and only when necessary to provide instruction.

Campus Cleaning

Every classroom will be sanitized before each session begins to ensure that your student enters a clean learning environment. Students will not be using classroom community items. Instead, each student will be utilizing their own set of materials.

Volunteering

Unfortunately, we are unable to permit volunteers on the main campus. You may, however, reach out to your child's to see if there are ways you can support your child's class from home. Please be advised that our campus is only open to students and staff.

Lunch

Meals from our Food Services team will be available for purchase daily. Your child will receive their meal as they leave campus at the end of their session. Students in the AM session will receive lunch for that day while PM students will get lunch intended for the following day.

Student Showing Symptoms of Illness while at School

If a student is presenting one of the listed symptoms, they will be sent to the OC Health Check Area to be triaged by our School Nurse, Health Clerk, or Office/Support Staff. In following the set-forth protocols, if it is determined that the student will need to go home, a parent or designated adult on the emergency contact list, will need to immediately come and pick-up the student.

We know that life on campus will look a little different, but our commitment to the safety and education of your child is our highest priority. Your cooperation will enable us to remain open and provide in-person instruction to our students.
