 - Checks can be made out to Vista del Lago. Please write CSF and your name in the memo portion of the check.
 - You will pay your membership dues at student accounts after you submit your
 application to Mr. Ruiz and receive a payment verification form. All payments must
 be made to Student Accounts by Friday, February 2nd at 4:00pm.
- □ Please assemble your application packet in the following order (**Do Not Staple!!**):
 - Completed Application
 - Grade Printouts
- □ Hand deliver your application to Mr. Ruiz(H-205) by 4:00pm on Friday January 26th.
 - You may not ask a teacher or office staff member to place your application in Mr. Ruiz's mailbox. You may not electronically submit your application. Applications submitted by either of these methods will <u>NOT</u> be accepted.

To qualify for CSF membership this semester, follow these guidelines:

- 1. You must earn a minimum of 10 points from last term's grades (School Year 20-23-24: Term 1: Quarters 1 and 2).
 - **a.** The first 4 points must be from LIST I.
 - **b.** The first 7 points (including the four points described in **a**) must be from LISTS I and II.
 - **c.** The remaining points may come from any LIST (I, II, or III).
- You must use no more than 5 courses to qualify. (If you were taking a full schedule you have 8 courses/grades to choose from.)
- NO CSF points are given for physical education, courses taken in lieu of physical education, subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving clerking and office/teaching assistant, and courses taken on a pass/fail basis.
- CSF points are granted as follows:
 - a grade of A = 3 CSF points
 - a grade of B = 1 CSF point
 - 1 additional point shall be granted for a grade of A or B in an AP or Honors course, up to a maximum of 2 such points per term.
 - a grade of C = 0 CSF points
 - a grade of D or F in any course, even in one you cannot use to qualify, disqualifies you from membership at this time.

Also remember:

- Term membership is based on work done in the previous term.
- You must reapply each term.
- Courses you may use are listed on the second page of this document. They are divided into LISTS I, II, and III. The last section identifies courses that cannot be used to qualify for CSF.
