Secondary COVID-19 Family Agreement

All of us at Mills are VERY excited to welcome our students and families back on campus! We also want you to know that Mills takes the health and well-being of our students, teachers, and staff very seriously. We commit to partnering with you to do all we can to ensure a safe and productive year for our students. Please read the commitments below and return the signature page to your homeroom teacher as a symbol of your agreement to partner with Mills during this unprecedented time. If we ALL work together and adhere to this agreement, then we as a school community are doing everything possible to keep our classrooms open for in-person instruction. We appreciate our families and believe that WE CAN DO THIS! The District response plan and procedures are not exhaustive and will be adjusted as guidelines change with the evolving situation. We will be in close contact with Sacramento County Public Health.

___ I understand that as a community we are dependent on everyone doing their role to lessen the spread of COVID-19 outside of school. I understand that if the rates of COVID-19 increase in the community, FCUSD may have to switch back to distance learning.

___ I understand that my student physically attending class on campus is contingent upon agreeing to, and scrupulously following, the requirements on this form. Those not wishing to agree to the following requirements will continue to engage with their teachers and peers through distance learning.

___ I commit to screen my student for symptoms consistent with COVID-19 every morning or afternoon before bringing him/her to school. FCUSD will communicate and offer training for the symptom screening app when available.

___ I commit to following the [SCPH Response Scenarios](#) and get tested if I, or my children, demonstrate symptoms of COVID or have known exposure.

___ I commit to communicate with the school of any [symptoms](#) or positive results/positive known exposure so that proper quarantine can be implemented to those affected. Please refer to this [Decision Tree](#).

___ I commit to being available to come pick up my student within 30 minutes if they are ill.

___ I commit to wearing a face covering and will maintain social distance if I *need* to go to the office. Please utilize email and phone calls whenever possible.

___ I commit to have my student wear a face covering and to wear masks with two or more layers over the nose and mouth and secure it under the chin. My student will NOT wear masks intended for healthcare workers, for example, N95 respirators. (CDC does not recommend the use of gaiters or face shields. Evaluation of these face covers is on-going but effectiveness is unknown at this time. Follow guidelines about materials and quality of face coverings.

___ I commit to encouraging my student to practice social distancing while at school.

___ I commit to encouraging my student to practice healthy hygiene habits including hand washing and hand sanitizing.

___ I commit to reminding my student to refrain from sharing snacks and supplies.

___ I commit to following FCUSD safety procedures and protocols. The procedures are not exhaustive and will be adjusted as guidelines change with the situation.

___ I commit to picking up my student on time when their school day is over. Loitering is not permitted.

___ I commit to making sure my student takes care of their Chromebook, brings it back and forth to school each day if required by the teacher, and keeps it charged.

___ If my student rides the bus, I commit to promote social distancing at the bus stop.

___ If my student walks to and from school, I commit to encouraging my child to practice social distancing.

___ I commit to dropping off my student no earlier than 8:00am to maintain the ability of staff to monitor students for safety protocols before school begins.

___ I commit to standard Immunization regulations required for school entry.
