How to write your weekly summaries for stock project... Each of these = 2.5% of the project grade which is 20% of the grade as a whole.

Write a paragraph that includes the information listed below. It must be more than 6 sentences long and give me a clear picture of how your portfolio has performed during the past week (Monday-Friday) and WHY your balance has risen or fallen in value. Use QUANTITATIVE terms when writing the paragraph NOT qualitative statements whenever possible.

Must be included in weekly summary...

- 1. Beginning and ending balance of your account value. (can be found under performance history)
- 2. Ranking in our competition at the beginning and end of the week Friday. (This is listed until Monday night on Rankings)
- 3. Name your best performing stock <u>based on % increase</u> in value and the amount of money you made based on the amount invested. You also need to <u>explain how much \$ you made</u>.
- 4. Name your worst performing stock <u>based on % increase/decrease</u> in value and the amount of money you made or lost based on the amount invested. You also need to explain *how much* \$ you made or lost.
- 5. Add "color commentary" explaining what factors logically led to the performance of your portfolio and those individual stocks that you listed as your best and worst performers.
- 6. Explain what stocks you bought/sold/traded and why.
- 7. If you didn't trade stocks, you should explain what your thoughts are on your current portfolio and any predictions (using news/logic) you have about future hopes for those company's stock performance.
- 8. Include at least 2 "why statements" to explain the performance of your stocks (individually or as a whole).

Note: Avoid statements like:

- Stock X did "pretty well"
- I made "a lot" of money from XYZ stock
- My stock is holding "pretty steady"
- My stock did "ok" this week
- This was a "solid" week for my stocks.

Instead, use statements like:

- Stock X went up 6% this week earning \$1,100 for me
- I made \$3,000 this week from XYZ stock
- My stock only changed .5% for the week
- My stock only gained \$200 this week.
- My portfolio gained \$1,500 this week and I gained 50 spots in the rankings.
