# **Daily Schedule**

- Lunches are 35 min.- 3 lunches for each grade level

# **Physical Education - PE**

- Daily
- Majority of 6th graders are in 6th grade locker room
- Students are issued lockers you provide the lock.
- Students wear PE uniform.
- Opportunity to be exposed to different sports/activities



# 6th Grade Elective Options

Please check Counselors' Section of SMS website for elective descriptions.

- **Elective Block** Two semester courses *could include* study skills, creative writing or art. Students do not have a choice on what they get.
- Beginning Band- Beginning music class. No experience required
- **Beginning Orchestra** Beginning music class. No experience required.

# Foreign Language Electives and Sequence

- Spanish- Spanish 1A (7th grade), Spanish 1B (8th grade)
- Spanish courses are rigorous; nightly practice is a requirement.
- A's and B's highly recommended before starting in a foreign language.
- 8th graders may not select Spanish 1A.



### STEM Academy

Please attend STEM info night on Thursday, 2/15, 6-7PM in Multi. See SMS website for more information.

- Students are chosen on a lottery system.
  - No testing
  - o If first choice is STEM les sure to have a second choice option selected
- Technology elective is built into schedule.
- Students cannot take zero period, Honors English, or skip a math level.
- Students travel together from class to class with the same set of teachers.
- 3 6th grade sections=105 students & 2 7th grade sections= 70 students

## **Advanced Courses**

- Honors English 6th-8th- Students do not have to test into Honors English.
   Incoming 6th grade students should have A/B grades in Reading and
   Writing as well as a Level 4 on STAR Reading Benchmark. See English department website for more info.
- Course 1 Honors Placement based on grades, STAR and CAASPP scores.
- Course 2 Honors- Placement based on grades, STAR and CAASPP scores and passing score on placement test which is taken at the elementary school.

## Registration and Elective Selection

- Steps to the registration/elective selection process can be found on the SMS website. Registration will open on 3/1/24.
- Families who live within FCUSD but not within SMS's school boundaries must fill out a school choice form. These forms were due to the home middle school on 2/2/24. Families will be contacted by the SMS office when/if their child is accepted to SMS.
- Families who are not enrolled in an FCUSD school currently, but live in SMS boundaries will also be able to register on March 1st. Parents should come to the office for paperwork.
- Classes are not filled on a first come first serve basis.
- Sutter Feeder Elementaries = SJGE, TJE, NSE, CSE, GRE and BSE

#### **Elective Selection Form**

- Families will choose their child's elective by completing the online Elective Selection Form available on the SMS website.
- Parents choose their child's elective or the STEM Academy.
- Families must choose a 1st and 2nd choice elective on the form.
- Students on IEP's will have a transition meeting to update their IEP in the Spring; Sutter staff will be in attendance to assist.

#### **Communication**



**Email is best!** We are here to help!

**Teachers**- Connect with teachers when you have questions/concerns about their specific class. Look on SMS website for classwork, homework, teacher info.

**Counselors**- Connect with your child's counselor when there are academic, social or emotional concerns. Review counseling section of SMS website.

**Assistant Principals**- Connect with an AP when there is a discipline issue. There is also an anonymous online bullying report form parents can access on the SMS website.
