1. Red and yellow composition books. The red composition book labeled with student name and *Math*. The Yellow composition book labeled with student name and *Language Arts*.
2. 2 pocket plastic folders in red, yellow, blue, green. Labeled with subject and student name and *Math* (Red), *Language Arts* (yellow), Social studies / Science (Blue), *Homework* (Green)
