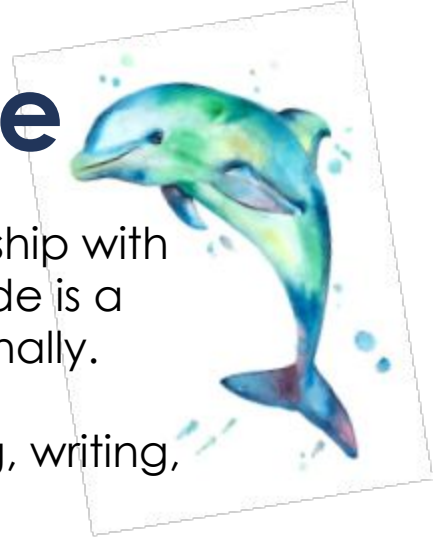

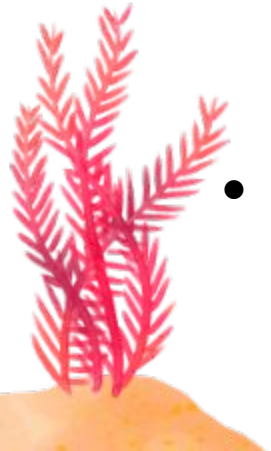


Welcome to First Grade

Help your child do their best learning everyday.

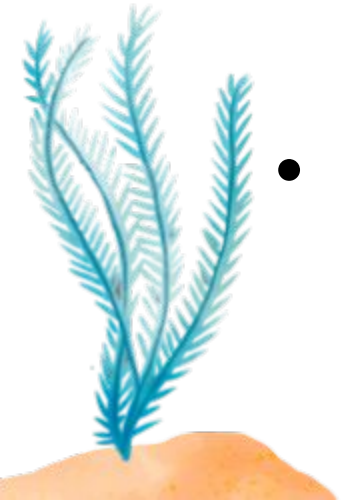
