STATEMENT ON PUBLIC MEETINGS AS PER ORDER OF THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO

As of January 6, 2022, The County of Sacramento Health Officer ordered all public meetings in the County to occur virtually until further notice. Accordingly, meetings of the Board of Education are not currently open for in-person attendance by members of the public.

The District has been advised that the Order will be reevaluated no later than February 1, 2022 by the Health Officer.

STATEMENT ON FACE COVERINGS

As a reminder, in addition to the State Health Order and corresponding face covering guidance, the Sacramento County Department of Public Health [local order](#), issued on July 29th, remains in place, requiring face coverings in all indoor public settings and workplaces, including school settings, except for individuals who are specifically exempted pursuant to CDPH mandate, wear face coverings while attending this meeting in-person.

Persons exempted from wearing a face mask due to a medical or mental condition must wear a non-restrictive alternative, such as a face shield with a drape on the bottom edge, as long as their condition permits it.
