Topic 1: One to Five

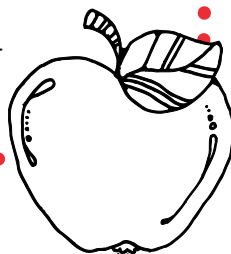
- Recognize numbers 1 to 5 in different arrangements

Topic 2: Comparing and Ordering 0 to 5

- Compare numbers from 0 to 5
- Compare sets of objects to identify if one group has more, fewer, or the same amount as the other group
- Learn about the number 0 and how to order the numbers 0 to 5

Topic 3: Six to Ten

- Learn numbers 6 to 10 and how to read and write them
- Represent quantities with objects
- Make 10 by combining two other quantities
