









Secondary Student Survey: Key Indicators






School Connectedness Scale (In-School) | Average percent of respondents reporting 'Strongly Agree' or 'Agree'



Perceived Safety at School | Average percent of respondents reporting 'Very Safe' or 'Safe'




Current Alcohol or Drug Use | One or more days in the past 30 days






