Bicycle, Skateboard and Scooter Contract

The privilege of riding a bike, skateboard or a scooter is permitted as long as the rider uses reasonable safety and follows school rules.

- At Oak Chan, bicycle, skateboard and scooter riding is limited to students in grades 3-5. Students in K-2 may ride when accompanied by an adult to and from school.
- Bicycles, skateboards and scooters are to be locked up in the bike area by the Dragon drop-off. The school is not responsible for damaged or stolen bike/skateboard/scooter.
- Teachers and staff have the right to confiscate any bike/skateboard/scooter if safety is not being followed.
- The following rules are designed for student safety. Violations can result in the loss of riding privileges.

Rules:

- Students riding bike/skateboard/scooter must wear bicycle helmets correctly, according to traffic laws.
- Students need to obey all traffic laws.
- Please watch out for all traffic and people.
- When arriving at or leaving the school, walk your bike/skateboard scooter at the intersections with the crosswalks only.
- When riding in front of the school, please ride on the side of the street nearest the park to avoid cars entering and exiting the school.
- Upon arrival at school, walk your bike/skateboard/scooter on the sidewalks and go directly to the bike racks.
- Never ride your bike/skateboard/scooter on the sidewalks.
- **E-Bikes and E-Scooters are not permitted.**
