High School Equivalency

Which one is right for you?

Both the high school diploma and high school equivalency certificate lead to the same result for most employment and educational opportunities. The process for earning each of them is different.

High School Diploma (HSD)

To earn a high school diploma, you must earn 160 credits.

High School Equivalency (GED or HiSET)

To earn a high school equivalency certificate, you must pass all subject area tests.



High School Equivalency HiSET






- Students risk being dropped for excessive or sporadic absences or for not making academic progress.

CASAS Assessments are Required!

"California Adult School Assessment System"

Today you will take an assessment on the computer so can see if you need any remedial assistance in Math and/or Reading.

The assessment begins with 12 practice questions that help the system determine which test you will take.

After, you will have about 1 hour to complete the rest of the assessment (for each Reading and Math).

Once you complete your test you'll return to the front office and meet with our registrar, Leanna Miller.
