

All Transitional Kindergarten (TK), Kindergarten and 1st Grade Students

There are four health requirements for TK, kindergarten and first grade students entering public school. If you have any questions about these requirements, please contact Folsom Cordova Unified School District Health Programs at (916) 294-9013. The four requirements are:

1. **IMMUNIZATIONS:** The State of California, under Law SB277, requires that all children have up-to-date IMMUNIZATIONS before entrance into public school. Please refer to the chart below. This chart can be found at www.shotsforschool.org

Vaccine	4-6 Years Old Elementary School at Transitional-Kindergarten/ Kindergarten and Above
Polio (OPV or IPV)	4 doses (3 doses OK if one was given on or after 4th birthday)
Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis	5 doses of DTaP, DTP, or DT (4 doses OK if one was given on or after 4th birthday)
Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR or MMR-V)	2 doses (Both given on or after 1st birthday. Only one dose of mumps and rubella vaccines are required if given separately.)
Hepatitis B (Hep B or HBV)	3 doses
Varicella (chickenpox, VAR, MMR-V, or VZV)	1 dose

Please bring your California Immunization Record or other official record from your healthcare provider when you register your child.

As of January 1, 2016, the state no longer allows Personal Belief Exemptions for required immunizations which include exemptions for religious beliefs. A temporary or permanent medical exemption to one or more of the immunizations may be granted under certain circumstances if a licensed physician (M.D. or D.O.) provides a written statement which states:

- That the physical condition or medical circumstances of the child are such that the required immunization(s) is not indicated.
- Which vaccines are being exempted
- Whether the medical exemption is permanent or temporary.
- The expiration date, if the exemption is temporary.

2. **PHYSICAL EXAM:** Children must have a PHYSICAL EXAM upon first grade entry. The law allows for the health examination to be completed up to 18 months prior to entry into first grade or within 90 days after entry into first grade. We will include this exam form for your future reference.

3. **ORAL HEALTH ASSESSMENT:** The law, AB1433, requires that children entering public school for the first time, in kindergarten or first grade, are to have a dental checkup by May 31 of the first school year. The evaluation must be completed by a licensed dental professional. Oral health evaluations that occurred within the 12 months prior to school entry also meet this requirement. Please bring your completed Oral Health Assessment form to the school when you register your child or upon completion of the child's next dental examination.

4. **MEDICATION POLICY:** All medication must have the appropriate signed forms. Medication must be stored in the health office. Please refer to InfoSnap for further instructions on the policy and to print the forms if needed.
