Online Registration for Returning Students is Now Open

Follow these easy steps as soon as possible and **no later than February 19th, 2016:**

1. Log in to your PowerSchool Parent (not student's) Portal. Remember that the portal is found on our website at www.fcusd.org/fhe.
2. Click on the InfoSnap link** found on the left side of the page (see back of this notice for a screenshot). If you have more than one student, be sure you are on the correct student's tab (tabs are located at the top of the page) in PowerSchool Parent.
3. Most information about your student has been uploaded from PowerSchool and will be in place. Simply review the information, make any changes, fill in any missing information, and press submit on the last page. The process should take about 10 minutes per student.
4. You're done! Teacher assignments for the 2016-2017 school year can be picked up in August (date TBA).

Helpful Tips:

- Make sure you log into the PowerSchool Portal as a **Parent** and not your student.
- You will need your student's medical insurance information, and confirm your emergency contact information.
- Red asterisks indicate required fields.
- If the 'submit' button on the last page isn't selectable, there are required fields you have not completed – scroll down this page and look for any place it says 'required' in red.
- If you need to stop without completing the process, click on the 'save and log out' button at the top right of the screen and your information will be saved for your return visit.
- Once submitted, you will no longer be able to edit your student's information.

INSTRUCTIONS Use this guide as a quick reference to help you determine whether children seeking admission to your school meet California’s school immunization requirements. For the actual laws, see Health and Safety Code, Division 105, Part 2, Chapter 1, Sections 120325-120380; California Code of Regulations, Title 17, Division 1, Chapter 4, Subchapter 8, Sections 6000-6075. If you have any questions, call the Immunization Coordinator at your local health department.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS To enter into public and private elementary and secondary schools (grades kindergarten through 12, including transitional kindergarten), children under age 18 years must have immunizations.

VACCINE	REQUIRED DOSES
Polio	4 doses at any age, but... 3 doses meet requirement for ages 4–6 years if at least one was given on or after the 4 th birthday ¹ ; 3 doses meet requirement for ages 7–17 years if at least one was given on or after the 2 nd birthday. ¹
Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis	Age 6 years and under: DTP, DTaP or any combination of DTP or DTaP with DT (diphtheria and tetanus) 5 doses at any age, but... 4 doses meet requirements for ages 4–6 years if at least one was on or after the 4 th birthday. ¹ Age 7 years and older: Tdap, Td, or DTP, DTaP or any combination of these 4 doses at any age, but... 3 doses meet requirement for ages 7–17 years if at least one was on or after the 2 nd birthday. ¹ If last dose was given before the 2 nd birthday, one more (Tdap) dose is required.
Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)	Age 4-6 years (kindergarten and above): 2 doses² both on or after 1 st birthday. ¹
	7th grade: 2 doses² both on or after 1 st birthday. ¹
	Age 7-17 years and not entering or advancing into 7th grade: 1 dose on or after 1 st birthday. ¹
Hepatitis B ³	Age 4-6 years (kindergarten and above): 3 doses.
Varicella	1 dose^{4, 6}
Tdap Booster (Tetanus, reduced diphtheria, and pertussis)	7th grade: 1 dose on or after 7 th birthday. ^{5, 7}

¹ Receipt of a dose up to (and including) 4 days before the birthday will satisfy the school entry immunization requirement.
² Two doses of measles-containing vaccine required. One dose of mumps and rubella-containing vaccine required; mumps vaccine is not required for children 7 years of age and older.
³ Not required for 7th grade.
⁴ Physician-documented varicella (chickenpox) disease history or immunity meets the varicella requirement.
⁵ Tdap, DTaP, or DTP given on or after 7th birthday will meet the requirement. Td does not meet the requirement.
⁶ 2 dose varicella requirement for ages 13-17 years applies to transfer students who were not admitted to a California school before July 1, 2001.
⁷ 8th-12th grade students transferring from outside of California must meet the requirement.

EXEMPTIONS The law allows parents/guardians to submit an exemption from immunization requirements based on their personal beliefs or medical conditions. For children with medical exemptions, the physician’s written statement should be submitted. Schools should maintain an up-to-date list of pupils with exemptions, so they can be excluded quickly if an outbreak occurs. For more information, visit shotsforschool.org

NOT MEETING REQUIREMENTS Refer pupils who do not meet these State requirements to their physician or local health department. Give families a written notice indicating which doses are lacking.

CONDITIONAL ADMISSIONS Children who lack one or more required vaccine doses that are not currently due may be admitted on condition that they receive the remaining doses when due (Title 17, CCR Section 6035).

FOLSOM CORDOVA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT HEALTH PROGRAMS

All Transitional Kindergarten, Kindergarten and 1st Grade Students

There are three health requirements for transitional kindergarten, kindergarten and first grade students entering public school. If you have any questions about these requirements, please contact Folsom Cordova Unified School District Health Programs at (916) 294-9013. The three requirements are:

1. The State of California requires that all children have up-to-date **IMMUNIZATIONS** before entrance into public school. All children must be fully immunized against Diphtheria, Pertussis and Tetanus (DPT), Polio, Rubeola (Measles), Mumps and Rubella (MMR), Hepatitis B and Varicella. Please bring your California Immunization Record or other official record from your healthcare provider when you register your child.
2. Children must have a **PHYSICAL EXAMINATION**. This exam can be completed as early as six months before entering transitional kindergarten or kindergarten, but no later than December of the first grade year. Please bring your completed School Entry Health assessment form to the school when you register your child.
3. Children must have an **ORAL HEALTH ASSESSMENT** completed by May 31 of their first year in public school entering transitional en, kindergarten or first grade. Dental evaluations that have been completed within the 12 months prior to school entry also meet this requirement. Please bring your completed Oral Health Assessment form to the school when you register your child.
