20 Questions

- Think of 20 questions people would want to know about your career.
- These can be general and specific.
- Find the answer, it needs to satisfy the question and give plenty of information.
- Single sentence answers usually do not provide enough information and will lead to more questions....avoid this.

20 Answers

- Answers can easily be used to help write the “What I found out” section of your career project.
- Will these twenty questions help you become a mini-expert on your career field or are you going to need more info.
- This is research and can be used in your research packet.

20 Q/ 20A

- Example ? : How much can you make in this career?
- Your answer should look to include a salary range. (Beginning level, mid-level, high-level)
- Compare states? Top location, etc.
- Don't be too general, find specifics.....
