+ SAT Testing Dates

- Sign up www.CollegeBoard.com
- Students are expected to sign up for and take the May 5th SAT exam. The fee is \$60. Students must register by April 6th. Late registration with an additional fee is April 17th.
- Students who cannot take the test on May 5th will be asked to sign up for and take the March 10th SAT.
- An alternate Saturday test date will be provided and required for students who cannot take the March/May test. These scores will not be official.

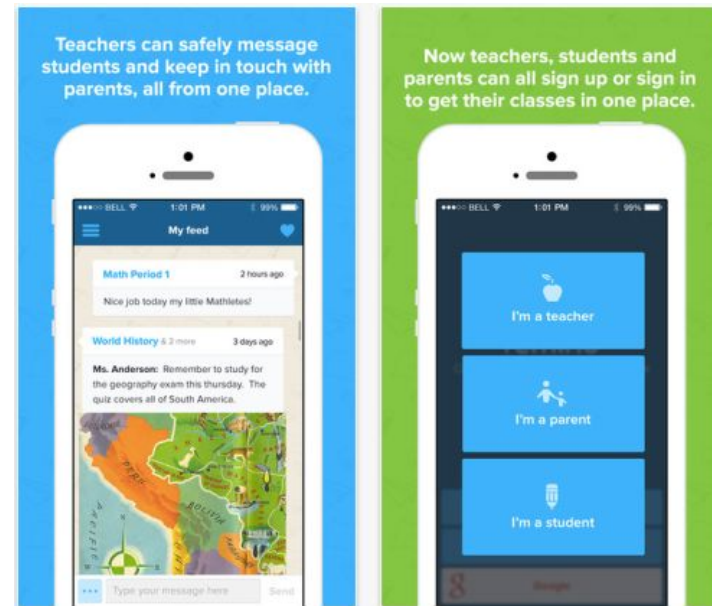
