Additional Recommendations - *These can be from outside Vista!*

- A service recommendation worksheet is required. An example of this recommender would be a supervisor of a volunteer event you participated at.
- A Leadership recommendation must also be submitted. An example of this could be an advisor of an organization or club where you demonstrated leadership experience.
