## Candidate Application

This is the bulk of your application where you can discuss your service, academic, and leadership experiences. Also included in this application are the names/emails of the teachers/recommenders who you will send the google forms to, so try to think ahead who you want your recommenders to be.

### Receiving Letters of Recommendation

First, access the Vista website

Academics→ Honor & Scholarship Societies→ NHS Application Information

You must submit 2 Teacher Character Evaluation Worksheets from teachers that you had last year or who know you very well as a student. The forms are on the Vista website, and forms must come directly to Ms. Moore from the recommender.

Additional Recommendations - These can be from outside Vista!

- A service recommendation worksheet is required. An example of this recommender would be a supervisor of a volunteer event you participated at.
- A Leadership recommendation must also be submitted. An example of this could be an advisor of an organization or club where you demonstrated leadership experience.
